Petitioner-Naveen has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.716 dated 29.07.2017, registered at Police Station City Hisar, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations, ₹3,70,000/- was given to the present petitioner by the mother-in-law of complainant for investment. As per the version of petitioner, ₹2 lakhs stands deposited in the name of Shanti Devi (mother-in-law of complainant) with Tata Life Insurance Company and remaining amount was paid to her in cash, who has now expired.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 22.02.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 22.02.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
