In this petition, the petitioners seek their release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.140, dated 28.08.2017, under Sections 436, 427, 511, 148, 149 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of the Explosive Substances Act, 1908, registered at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. All the petitioners have undergone detention in excess of three months by now.

3. Investigation has already been completed and challan is submitted.
