Petitioner No.1 is the father-in-law of respondent No.2/complainant. The allegations against him are that he tried to outrage the modesty of the complainant. The allegations are that the mother-in-law of the complainant on the pretext of taking soap knocked at the door of the bathroom. When the complainant opened the door, father-in-law forcibly entered the bathroom and tried to misbehave with the complainant.

Allegations of impotency has been levelled against the husband. Petitioner No.1 is a retired District Sports Officer and is stated to be training Female Wrestlers of International Caliber. His wife is working as an Associate Professor in a girl college.

Custodial interrogation is not necessary. There are no allegation that the petitioner would flee from the country, no recovery is to be effected.

On instructions from ASI Surinder Pal Singh, it has been informed that the petitioners have already joined the investigation.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 09.02.2018 is hereby made absolute subject to all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
