AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that a compromise has been entered into between the petitioners and the complainant-Sarabjit Singh. He further states that this is not an injury case and, therefore, the matter having been settled, the petitioners would appear before the Illaqa Magistrate, Ludhiana, on 27.02.2018 and move an application for grant of regular bail.

In case the petitioners appear before the Illaqa Magistrate, Ludhiana, on 27.02.2018 and surrender to the jurisdiction of the Court and move an application for grant of regular bail, keeping in view the fact that a compromise has been entered into between the parties, which fact is admitted by Sh. Gautam Dutt, Advocate, who puts in appearance on behalf

of the complainant, the said application for grant of regular bail shall be accepted and they shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the said Court.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
