In this petition, the petitioner seek his release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.217, dated 02.05.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 427, 452, 506 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25-54-59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention since 11.10.2017.
3. Investigation has already been completed and challan is submitted.
4. While according to the F.I.R., the petitioner is alleged to have fired at the victim, but the firearm recovered from him during investigation as per the Report sent up by the Forensic Science Laboratory, Madhuban,

describes the said firearm as being a toy pistol.

5. In this circumstance, further indefinite detention of the petitioner is not justified.

6. In view of above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely Jaspreet Singh @ Rohit Sethi son of Paramjeet Singh, is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
