Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 108 dated 9.12.2017, registered under Sections 498-A IPC, Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Service has been effected on respondent No. 2 but no one has put in appearance on her behalf.

Counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 9.2.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for further investigation.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 9.2.2018 granting

interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
