ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.276 dated 27.12.2017, registered under Sections 376 IPC, Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Complainant has placed on record copy of the affidavits in compliance of order dated 09.02.2018 and states that there was no divorce decree from the Court and divorce was obtained in Panchayat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 09.02.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 09.02.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
