Prayer made in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate action in the subject matter involving the plot which was devolved upon the petitioner by virtue of Will dated 31.07.1996 executed by Sukhdev Kaur.

The alleged attempt of respondents No.5 to 9 in taking forcible possession of the house was reported to the police and a representation was also filed on 26.04.2017 before respondent No.2. The said representation was marked to respondent No.3 and ultimately, respondent No.4 was appointed as Investigating Officer of the issue. The allegations have been

made against respondent No.4 who even during pendency of the civil litigation has threatened the petitioner to hand over the possession of the property to the private respondents.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Add., AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondent-State.

At this stage, no finding in respect of veracity of allegations can be recorded and this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representation (Annexure P1) dated 26.04.2017 made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
