MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of Complaint RBT No.104/1 dated 23.05.1995, registered under Sections 427, 447, 435, 379, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (**Annexure P-1**), vide which the petitioner along with other accused were summoned under Sections 447, 427, 379, 435, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, S.B.S. Nagar, vide order dated 30.10.1995 (**Annexure P-2**) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was earlier declared as proclaimed offender on 08.06.2001 (**Annexure P-3**) by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, S.B.S.Nagar in spite of the fact that he was abroad at that time and he was not even served in that case. Learned Counsel for the petitioner further submits that, in terms of order dated 22.03.2018, the

petitioner has surrendered before the learned trial Court and joined the proceedings and granted interim bail by the learned trial Court.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner stated that he will be satisfied if order dated 22.03.2018 is made absolute.

In view of above, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.03.2018 is made absolute.

Disposed off accordingly.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall continue to co-operate with the learned trial Court and shall not repeat such lapse(s) in future.
