The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.119 dated 20.10.2017 (in which cross version of the complainant has been added vide G.D. No.023 dated 21.10.2017 in the said FIR got registered by co-accused, namely, Palwinder Singh), registered at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda, under Sections 308, 323 and 34 IPC.

It is not in dispute that pursuant to order dated 12.02.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperating therewith. Mr. Amit Goyal, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has submitted that the grievous injuries have been caused by the petitioner and therefore, he does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

Keeping in view the fact that the interim order dated 12.02.2018 passed by this Court has been complied with by the petitioner and that no further recovery is to be effected from him, I deem it appropriate to confirm the said order.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.02.2018 is made absolute.
