This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code ('Cr.P.C.' - for short) for grant of regular bail in FIR No.385 dated 25.08.2017, under Section 364, 120-B, 379 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

Ms. Palak Dev, Advocate put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed her Vakalatnama in the Court today and same is taken on record. Counsel for the complainant states that compromise (Annexure P-2) has now been effected between the parties.

It has been submitted that petitioner is conspirator and nothing has been recovered from him on 23.10.2017.

Heard both sides.

Consequently, this Court is of the view that it would be just and appropriate if the concession of bail is granted to the petitioner. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Samasbir be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
