This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 452, 307, 364, 323, 148, 149 IPC and under Sections 25/27/54/59 Arms Act at Police Station, South Moga, District, Moga vide F.I.R No. 131 dated 25.6.2016.

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that offence under Section 307 has been deleted and petitioner has joined the investigation pursuant to order dated 8.5.2017 and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 8.5.2017 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
