This petition has been filed under section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to conclude the investigation in case FIR No.19, dated 10.03.2016, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur, under sections 324/323/506 read with sections 148, 149 IPC and to submit the final report, under section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. before the competent Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the investigation in the case is pending since March 2016 and therefore, the police may be directed to expeditiously conclude its investigation.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let four copies of complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to respondents No.4 to 15.
