Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take action against the private respondents on the representation dated 04.07.2016 (Annexure P1) given by the petitioner.

Reply by way of affidavit of SSP, Amritsar-Rural, is already on record and as per the the same, the inquiry on the application of the petitioner was marked to SP, Investigation (Amritsar) Rural, and on the basis of the inquiry report, it is revealed that the family members of the petitioner i.e. wife and children, have deposed that the mental condition of the petitioner is not stable and he is under-treatment with different hospitals. It is also stated that the petitioner could not produce any substantive evidence in support of the allegations levelled in the application and, thereafter, on the basis of the inquiry report, the complaint was consigned. The affidavit is supported by inquiry reports (Annexure R1/T to Annexure R4/T).

In view of the same, the present petition is rendered as infructuous.
