The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 828 dated 16.09.2017, registered under Section 17 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

The petitioner was arrested on 16.09.2017 as he was in possession of 610 grams of Opium. FSL report has also been received. According to which the contraband recovered has been identified to be Opium.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that non-commercial quantity has been recovered and that the investigation is complete and challan has already been presented.

Learned State counsel has not been able to dispute the contentions made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the fact that recovery of non-commercial quantity of opium has been made from the petitioner and that the investigation is complete, challan has been present and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in

custody, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
