This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') on behalf of the petitioner, who was arrested on 29.10.2017 in case FIR No.178, dated 27.10.2017 (wrongly mentioned as 26.10.2017 in Annexure P-4), registered under Sections 392, 34 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, (for short, 'the IPC') at Police Station Bichhore, District Nuh.

Petitioner has remained in detention since 29.10.2017. Challan has since been presented after completion of the investigation.

Further, the petitioner appears to have compromised his dispute with the complainant, as seen from the copies of the two affidavits placed on record as Annexures P-2 and P-3, which fact also brought to the notice of the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, and the same fact also finds mention in the impugned order passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Nuh dated 29.01.2018.

As such, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified. The present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
