This order will dispose of first bail application, filed by petitioners, under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for releasing them on bail in FIR No. 4, dated 8.1.2018, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B IPC at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, Batala District Gurdaspur.

The allegation alleged in FIR is that Moni Masih, son of petitioners, enticed away the prosecutrix on the pretext of marriage in connivance with them. Present petitioners were arrested on 9.1.2018 and are in custody since then.

In this case, prosecutrix has been recovered. The police file produced which shows that statement of prosecutrix under Section 164 Cr.P.C. has been recorded, in which she has stated that she has accompanied son of petitioners voluntarily and has married him. She also claims that she has got a certificate of marriage.

CRM No. M-5801 of 2018 (O/M)

In these circumstances, without commenting on merits of case, present bail application is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- each, with one surety of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
