Following is the prayer in the present petition:-

“Petition under Section 482 Cr. P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.728 dated 11.10.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad and other consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise deed dated 07.03.2017 (Annexure P-2)”.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the parties to the present petition and in particular the complainant and the petitioners have arrived into a compromise and a copy thereof is placed as Annexure P-2. He submits that the terms and conditions in the compromise have been honored inasmuch as the sale-deed has also

been executed as stated in Para-1 of the compromise deed.

Learned counsel for the complainant has categorically stated that indeed the compromise has been arrived at and therefore, the complainant does not want to prosecute the petitioners in the FIR in question.

In that view of the matter, looking to the nature of dispute, I think quashment of FIR in question should be allowed. In the result, I make the following order:-

ORDER

- (i) Rule is made absolute in terms of prayer clause;
- (ii) Consequently, FIR No.728 dated 11.10.2016, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad along with other consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
