Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.212 dated 21.11.2017 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Gurwinder Singh, states that the petitioner-Harpal Singh is not only a beneficiary, he had impersonated his own elder brother Gopal Singh, who had died on 31.01.2008. The sale deed was executed on 05.09.2016. In this manner, the allegation being serious against the petitioner as he had impersonated his own brother Gopal Singh in the execution of sale deed. Petitioner is not entitled for the relief of anticipatory bail. He further states that the petition for grant of anticipatory bail filed by the co-accused Balwant Singh in CRM-M-4712-2018 titled as “Balwant Singh Versus State of Punjab” has

In view of the allegations against the petitioner where he has impersonated his own brother Gopal Singh, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
