By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the orders dated 08.08.2011 (Annexure P-8) and 25.08.2011 (Annexure P-9).

Learned State counsel informs that in pursuance of interim order, the petitioners have been paid the salary as prayed in the present petition, therefore, no cause of action survives. Petitioner No.1 served with the office of Advocate General Punjab till 30.06.2017, whereas, petitioner No.2 still continues with the office of Advocate General Punjab on a higher post.

Heard.

Considering the fact that in terms of interim order, the amount prayed for stands paid recovery of which will be harsh, at this

stage. Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondents that the amount so paid be not recovered from the petitioners.

As the order is being passed in the absence of learned senior counsel for the petitioner, if any cause of action still survives, the petitioners are at liberty to revive the present within three months from today.
