1. Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.98 dated 18.09.2012 under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran.

2. Petitioner was initially granted bail. His bail was cancelled on account of his absence on 20.09.2013. Thereafter, he surrendered on 21.04.2014 and was granted bail. On 07.12.2015, he again absented himself and ultimately, declared to be proclaimed offender vide order dated 18.04.2016.

3. Petitioner was arrested only on 29.05.2017 after a period of more than one year of his absence.

4. Owing to the conduct of the petitioner, he does not deserve any concession of regular bail during the trial.

5. This petition is accordingly, dismissed.
