In this petition, the petitioner prays for being released on bail after a warrant of arrest has ordered to be issued against him in case FIR No.235 dated 15.11.2016, under Section 379-B of the IPC and Section 411 of the IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

[2]. The petitioner was earlier on bail but could not appear before the Ld. Court below on 02.12.2017. His explanation in this regard is that he being drug addict was in a poor physical condition on the relevant date and had been, therefore, kept confined at his home. The next returnable date in the Ld. Court below happens to be today itself.

[3]. In view of the explanation given by the petitioner for his non-appearance for the relevant date, the matter is disposed off by staying operation of the pending coercive processes issued against him for one week with a liberty to him to surrender before the Ld. Court below within that much time and seeks fresh bail.

[4]. This order shall automatically stand vacated after the evening of 19.02.2018.
