Mr. Karan Garg, Advocate puts in appearance and files his Memorandum of Appearance on behalf of the complainant/respondent No.1 and submits that talks of compromise between the parties are going on and he has no objection if the petitioner is permitted to go abroad to meet his daughter who is settled there, and which prayer was rejected by the Ld. Court below vide impugned order dated 30th January, 2018 (Annexure P-6) by observing that such permission could not be granted in view of the direction of this Court to adjourn the pending proceedings beyond the date fixed.

In the given circumstances, the impugned order is set aside on consent of Ld. Counsel for the complainant and the petitioner is permitted to go abroad for which purpose his Passport may be returned to him subject to imposition of appropriate terms and conditions by the Ld. Court below.
