This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned authorities to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana-respondents No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-4) within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. He is further directed to submit status report before concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. and others**; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979. However, in the meanwhile, if the petitioner is not required for investigation pertaining to a cognizable offence, then he should not be called to the police station except with prior permission of the concerned Magistrate.
