Grievance of the petitioner in this petition is that despite registration of FIR No. 0605 dated 21.06.2017, under Sections 307, 323, 328, 34, 406, 498-A, IPC, no action was taken by the police authorities and final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., had not been submitted. Notice of motion was issued to respondents no. 1 to 6 on this ground.

As per reply by way of affidavit dated 11.05.2018 of Siddharath Dhanda, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hisar, it is mentioned that investigation in the matter was conducted and allegations pertaining to Sections 307 and 328 IPC were not found to be made out. Consent for lie detector test was moved by the Investigating Agency before the Court of learned Illaqa Magistrate on 16.08.2017. The same was allowed on the same day and lie detector test of respondents no.7, 8 and 10 was conducted.

Investigation was carried out. Respondents no. 9 and 10 were found innocent. Final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., has been presented on 21.03.2018 wherein respondents no.7 and 8 are being proceeded against and respondents no.9 and 10 have been kept in column no.2.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as narrated above,

no further orders are called for in this case.

Needless to say, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the remedy/remedies as may be available to her in accordance with law including the right to challenge the action of the police authorities in not proceeding against the accused named in the FIR or for the offences as alleged by her.

Petition is accordingly disposed of.
