The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.34, dated 23.01.2018, under Sections 452/324/34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

FIR has been registered on the complaint of Amarjit Kaur, who happens to be the petitioner's aunt. Occurrence is stated to be of 22.01.2018.

The specific allegation against the petitioner are with regard to trespass and having assaulted the complainant as also one Sajjan Singh with an iron pipe.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh apprises the Court that the complainant Amarjit Kaur had suffered a number of injuries with a blunt weapon including on the head.

Counsel for the petitioner would argue that the complainant Amarjit Kaur had been staying separately from her husband Dalip Kumar i.e.

Taya Ji of the petitioner since the last 10 years and now such allegations have surfaced and which would be indicative of false implication. Further submitted that the petitioner is a young man of 25 years and accordingly, is entitled to interim protection.

In the light of the specific attribution made by the complainant to the petitioner as regards trespass as also inflicting injuries with an iron pipe and that too, on the vital part of the body, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.
