The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.5 dated 18.1.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 458, 323, 34 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

Heard.

The allegation against the petitioners are that they have caused simple hurt to the other party. Parties have a fight over trivial issue. The complainant party also suffered injuries and it is a case of version and cross-version.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh

recovered from them.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 12.2.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
