This is the second petition preferred by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.190 dated 04.12.2017 under Sections 307, 336, 323, 34 and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Briefly noticed, case of the prosecution is that the complainant-Gurdeep Singh suffered a number of fire arm injuries on his right leg and at the hands of co-accused/Manmohan Singh.

The fire arm allegedly used by Manmohan Singh is stated to be a licensed weapon in the name of the present petitioner.

Injured has suffered an amputation on his right leg.

On a specific query having been put, counsel concedes

that no missing report had been lodged by the petitioner as regards his licensed weapon, which is alleged to have been used by main accused Manmohan Singh.

It may also be noticed that the first petition preferred by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. had come up for hearing before this Court on 22.01.2018 and it was after arguments having been raised at considerable length that the petition was withdrawn as per prayer made by counsel.

No intervening circumstances have been cited that would justify the filing of the present second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

Petition dismissed.
