The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to conduct free and impartial investigation in case FIR No.95 dated 18.12.2017, under Section 354 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Mullanpur.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against respondent No.4, despite the representation dated 18.12.2017 (Annexure P-2). Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. A.S. Sandhu, Addl. AG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the

representation of the petitioner within a period of six weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 18.12.2017 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
