Present petition has been filed praying for quashing of FIR No.275 dated 23.12.2013 (**Annexure P-1**), under Sections 63, 65 and 68 of the Copyright Act, 1957, registered at Police Station Mataur, District S.A.S. Nagar (Ajitgarh) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 17.03.2017, passed the following order:-

“ *Inter alia contends that even if the allegations contained in the FIR are taken at their face value yet no violation/infringement of the Provisions of the Copy Right Act would be made out.*

Notice of motion, returnable for 28.04.2017.

Notice re: stay as well. ”

It transpires that in pursuance of aforesaid order, reply was filed by the State/respondent No.1, wherein it has been, *inter alia*, stated that during investigation, petitioner was found innocent and was kept in Column No.2.

In view of above, no occasion to quash the FIR in question on behalf of the petitioner. If at all, the petitioner is aggrieved against any adverse order that may be passed against him during the pendency of the proceedings, resulting out of the FIR mentioned above, he may take recourse according to law.

Disposed off accordingly.
