This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, who was arrested on 09.10.2017 in case FIR No.874 dated 07.10.2017, under Sections 384, 386, 388 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat (Annexure P-1).

[2]. It transpires that the investigation has already been completed and challan has been submitted against the petitioner. Other co-accused have already been released on bail. In the circumstances, her further detention for indefinite period is not justified.

[3]. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, she is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/ Chief Duty Magistrate, concerned.
