RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(Oral)

1. Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.285 dated 26.08.2015 under Sections 379-B, 201, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar.

2. Complainant Madhu Sharma lodged the FIR with the allegations that when she was going to PMC Store B Block to purchase some grocery items then two boys came on motorcycle and snatched her purse containing an amount of Rs.10,000/-, card of Amway and one Samsung mobile having sim of Vodafone Company.

3. Petitioner was arrested on the basis of disclosure

statement of co-accused Harpreet Singh on 13.01.2017.

4. Recovery of Rs.7000/- has been effected from the petitioner whereas remaining amount and mobile phone have been recovered from co-accused Harpreet Singh.

5. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh submits that challan has already been presented on 02.03.2017 and charges have been framed on 02.09.2017. Out of total 13 prosecution witnesses, Investigating Officer and the complainant herself have been examined and the next date before the trial Court is 27.02.2018 for remaining evidence.

6. Petitioner is in custody since 13.01.2017. The trial may take some time in its final culmination.

7. In view of above, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

8. Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
