This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.203 dated 17.09.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 379, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 12.02.2018:-

"Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.203 dated 17.09.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 379 & 506 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel contends that it is a case of version and cross-version. Cross version even though recorded on 10.10.2017 yet the petitioner is stated to have been medically examined on 14.09.2017 itself.

Furthermore, counsel argue that it is a case of

simple injury.

Notice of motion, returnable for 23.03.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ajit Singh informs the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

It has also gone uncontroverted that the injury attributed to the present petitioner and on the person of the complainant has been opined to be simple in nature.

In view of the above, prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Order dated 12.02.2018, passed by this Court is made absolute.
