The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.68 dated 6.7.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 306, 34 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station Kathgarh, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar (Nawanshahr).

Heard.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that Gurpreet Singh had committed suicide by consuming poisonous substance. However, he left behind a suicide note wherein he mainly accused his wife. However, he also referred the conduct of the family of his in-laws. No specific allegations has been levelled against the petitioners.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long

time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioners-Raj Kaur wife of Amrik Singh, Amrik Singh son of Raja Singh and Devinder Singh son of Amrik Singh are ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioners shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of their absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioners shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel their bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure their presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioners shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) They shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
