This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.182 dated 25.12.2017, under Sections 21/65/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station 'C' Division, District Amritsar.

Notice of motion was issued on 14.02.2018.

Thereafter matter was taken up on 23.02.2018 and the following order was passed by this Court:-

“During the course of arguments it has gone uncontroverted that the present petitioner has been implicated only on the statement of coaccused with the allegations that he was pillion riding the Activa scooter and had run away from the spot and was carrying 10 grams of heroin.

List on 16.4.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

State counsel upon instructions from ASI Harnek Singh apprises the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

Petitioner is stated to be not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

For the reasons recorded above, prayer made in the petition is accepted.

Order dated 23.02.2018, passed by this Court is made absolute.
