The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.108, dated 08.06.2012, under Sections 406/420 IPC, registered at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib as also all other proceedings emanating therefrom.

Sole contention raised by counsel representing the petitioner is that the dispute is essentially civil in nature and has been given a criminal flavour.

Be that as it may, it has gone uncontroverted that investigation in the matter having been completed, challan was presented and thereafter even charges have been framed on 10.06.2017.

Trial is stated to be at the stage of prosecution evidence.

In view of the above, this Court would not be inclined to intervene in the matter and to accept the prayer for quashing of FIR.

Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

It is, however, clarified that dismissal of the instant petition

would not preclude the petitioner from raising all pleas that may be available to him in his defence and in accordance with law.

Dismissed.
