Notice in the application.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Jaspreet Kaur, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy of the application already stands furnished to learned State counsel.

In view of the averments made in the application and the submissions advanced by counsel, the necessary corrections as prayed for are allowed. The offences under Sections 325 and 201 IPC would now stand incorporated in the Head Note as also in the Prayer Clause in the main petition seeking benefit of regular bail. That apart the name of the Police Station concerned would now be read as Police Station Sadar Jagraon instead of Police Station Sadar Ludhiana.

Registry is directed to carry out the necessary changes.

Application disposed of.

**Main Case**

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.117 dated 07.08.2016, under Sections 307, 452, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149, 427, 325 and 201 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Kewal Singh S/o Sarwan Singh in relation to an alleged occurrence dated 06.08.2016 during late evening hours. Complainant alleged that when his sons Satnam Singh and Surinder Singh were preparing to close the shop then the present petitioner along with co-accused, Harmanjit Singh, Hardeep Singh, Jaspreet Singh, Harinderpal Singh, Honey Singh as also 8-9 other unknown persons, who were armed entered the shop and attacked Satnam Singh. Thereafter, even wife of the complainant, Manjit Kaur was also assaulted and inflicted injuries.

Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned his name was not mentioned as per initial version and came up in supplementary statement recorded of injured Satnam Singh and Manjit Kaur.

Petitioner was arrested on 14.08.2017.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Jaswinder Singh, Police Station Sadar Jagraon, Ludhiana (Rural) concedes that there is no opinion from the doctor as regards any injury on the person of Satnam Singh and which may have been opined to be dangerous to life.

It has further gone uncontroverted that during the course of trial complainant Kewal Singh as also injured Satnam Singh and Manjit Kaur have been examined and have not supported the prosecution version.

In view of the above and keeping in view the length of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, he is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

Disposed of.
