Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.194 dated 25.08.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 188, 427, 436, 120-B, 153-A, 124-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Varinder Kumar.

Allegations are against a number of assailants out of which two are identified and who after pronouncement of the verdict against Gurmit Ram Rahim had caused damage to diesel vending machines in the Khush Hal Petrol Pump being run by the complainant.

Present petitioner was one of the two who was identified by the complainant.

Petitioner was arrested on 25.08.2017.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of Gandasi, chilly powder and one empty bottle was effected.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan has been presented. Charges have also been framed.

Trial is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Petitioner has already faced incarceration of almost 06 months.

Co-accused Karambir @ Karam has been granted benefit of bail in the light of order dated 16.01.2018 in CRM No.M-708 of 2018.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Kaithal.
