The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case DDR No.19 dated 4.10.2012 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 Indian Penal Code in FIR No.112 dated 26.9.2012 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and 452 IPC added later on, at Police Station Kamboh, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajbir Singh states that only simple injury has been attributed to the petitioners whereas grievous injury has been attributed to co-accused Pargat Singh alias Kalu. It has also been stated that the petitioners have joined investigation and recovery has been made from them.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 14.2.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
