Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of regular by filing this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, in FIR No.856, dated 06.10.2017, registered at Police Station Suraj Kund, District Faridabad, under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of CRM-M-44781-2017, titled as 'Ashok Kumar Oberoi & others Vs. State of Haryana', the matter stands compromised between the parties, which fact could not be disputed by the counsel for the complainant.

In the light of the fact that the matter stands compromised and post dated cheques have been issued by the three other co-accused namely

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Ashok Kumar Oberoi, Ravinder Choudhary and Gurdia @ Johny Choudhary, the continuation of the petitioner in custody would not serve any useful purpose.

In view of the abovesaid facts and circumstances of the case, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
