Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions in the context of prosecution of a case against correct person with correct culpability.

According to learned counsel for the petitioner, an information was given to the Chowki Incharge, Anaj Mandi, Kaithal on 18.12.2017 in respect of commission of cognizable offence. No action was taken by the police, rather FIR was registered against unknown persons. Feeling aggrieved with the in-action on the part of the police, the petitioner contacted the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal.

Though, there is no written proof of such representation before the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, but learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance of the

petitioner was duly ventilated before him.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. S.P. Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondents No.1 and 2.

In view of facts and circumstances of the case and without meaning anything on the merits of the case, at this stage, it would be just and appropriate to ask respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the grievance of the petitioner, for which petitioner undertakes to file a detailed representation before respondent No.2 in addition to the communication earlier made by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today. In the event of receiving such a representation, the same shall be dealt with by respondent No.2 in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
