The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 192 dated 09.08.2017, registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 307, 341, 506 & 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Mullana, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the photographs showing that the injured has resumed his daily pursuits but the photographs placed on record by the complainant show that the complainant was horribly injured.
