By way of the common order, this Court shall dispose of two
petitions bearing *CRM-M-6181-2018 (Amrit Kaur and another Vs. State of
U.T. Chandigarh and another)* and *CRM-M-6423-2018 (Jitwar Singh Vs.*

U.T. Chandigarh and another) for quashing of FIR No.13 dated 04.11.2015 registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 420, 120-B of IPC at Police Station WPS, Chandigarh City and the consequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

The parties had arrived at a statement before the mediators. There were certain conditions which were to be fulfilled. Today in the connected petition bearing *CRM-M-14531-2017* the complainant's counsel had informed that they had received the guarantee papers which are valid till November, 2018. The main petition which was filed by Amrit Kaur and another has been withdrawn on account of the compromise.

The parties were sent for their statements to the Court below. The statements have been recorded.

In view of the statements, the petitions are allowed and the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof are quashed.

Needless to say that the parties will be bound by the agreement.
