The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 103 dated 24.03.2017, registered under Sections 323, 34, 406, 498-A and 506 of the IPC at Police Station NIT, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

The matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for an amicable settlement, however, the same was not successful. Counsel for the respondent-State submits on the direction of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and most of the dowry

articles have been recovered including gold articles and only a Scorpio Car and cash of ₹ 5 Lakh, as stated by the complainant, are left to be recovered.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the said car was sold as far back as 2014 while denying that any cash was received.

I have heard counsel for the parties.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 15.02.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438, Sub Section (2) Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The litigation expenses of ₹ 20,000/-, deposited with the Registry of this Court, be released in favour of the complainant/respondent No. 2 forthwith.
