This petition has been filed seeking direction to respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioners and in case the petitioners have to be summoned, Section 160 Cr.P.C. may be complied with.

Notice of motion. Mr. Nishchal Mann, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the son of the petitioners, namely, Gurminder Singh is the accused in case FIR No.589 dated 16.11.2017, registered at Police Station Pehowa, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC. Said Gurminder Singh has already been disinherited by the petitioners and they are not in touch with him any longer. A representation dated 08.02.2018 (Annexure P-1) has already been made to respondent No.2, but it has not yielded any result.

In view of the fact that representation dated 08.02.2018 has already been filed, this petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the allegations made in the said representation and to take appropriate action in accordance with law, after associating the petitioners

with their enquiry, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioners are required to be summoned for investigation, notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. will be issued to them.
