The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.161 dated 24th December, 2017, registered under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa.

2. It transpires from the submission of Ld. Counsel for the State that the investigation against the petitioner is already complete and challan presented.

3. As noted in the earlier order passed on 23rd February, the alleged recovery from the petitioner was well below the commercial quantity and also there was no record of his involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act.

4. In the circumstances, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not called for at this stage. As such, the interim bail granted to him earlier is hereby confirmed.
