[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let a copy of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

[3]. In this petition, the petitioner prays for being released on bail in case FIR No.71 dated 08.06.2017, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kot Isah Khan, District Moga. He was earlier on regular bail but absented from proceedings on 04.12.2017. His explanation in this regard is that he could not appear due to mistake in the communication of date in the Ld.
