Petitioner is facing trial in case FIR No.112 dated 20.04.2013 for the offences punishable under Section 382 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Division 8, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Earlier notice was issued to the petitioner but he did not appear and then his bailable warrants were issued which received back unserved. Ultimately, his bail order was cancelled and bail bonds/surety bonds were forfeited to the State and he was ordered to be summoned through non-bailable warrants. Now he is ready to join the proceedings.
