Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.50 dated 25.03.2017 under Sections 224/332/333/353/307/436/427/186/148/149/120-B IPC and Section 52-A of Prisoners Act, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused of the petitioner namely Partap Singh and Jasbir Singh @ Kaka have been granted the concession of regular bail vide order dated 29.01.2018 passed in CRM-M-1801-2018 and order dated 08.02.2018 passed in CRM-M-3624-2018 respectively. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial lockup since 25.03.2017 and conclusion of the trial will take long time.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagjeet Singh, has

not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial lock up since 25.03.2017; co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted concession of regular bail by this Court and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail, if the petitioner is found misusing the concession of bail, in any manner.

Petition is disposed of.
