Prayer made in this petition is for issuance of necessary directions to the official respondent No.2 in the context of protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioner from being invaded at the hands of respondent No.3 against whom allegations of favourism have been made.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that respondent No.4 is the wife of petitioner, who is harassing the petitioner in collusion with respondent No.3.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioner has also moved a representation before respondent No.2 on 09.10.2017 and the said representation is pending consideration before him.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G.,

Punjab, accepted notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2. Let requisite copies of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the pleadings contained in the present petition, since the allegations have been made against respondent No.3, therefore, respondent No.2 is directed to take into consideration the pending representation moved by the petitioner on 09.10.2017 and take appropriate action in accordance with law, without being swayed away by any consideration in terms of pleadings or anything recorded in the preceding part of the order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
